## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled, accepted, or awaiting acceptance to a college or university in an undergraduate or graduate program for the 2018 - 2019 academic year.
- Applicant, parent, or guardian must be or become a member of Naveo by submission deadline\*.
- Deadline for submission is Friday, March 9, 2018.
- Only completed applications that follow essay guidelines will be considered. See reverse for application.
- Previous winners are not eligible to win consecutive years.

## APPLICANTS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- Financial need (may be verified)
- Academic merit
  - Certified official transcript required through the end of first semester or second trimester; First year college students are required to submit a high school transcript in addition to their college transcript; Graduate students are required to submit undergraduate transcript(s) in addition to graduate transcripts.
- School and community involvement in the past two years
- Essay; 400- 500 words, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font.  
Essay Topic: "Explain the importance of your major in today's society."

**The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision regarding scholarship recipients and payment will be made directly to the college/university selected.**

**Applications must be received by Friday, March 9, 2018.** Scholarship recipients will be notified on or before March 28, 2018. Scholarships will be presented on April 5, 2018.

- 400 - 500 word essay, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font on the topic: "Explain the importance of your major in today's society."
