- Applicant, parent, or guardian must be or become a member of Naveo by submission deadline\*.
- Minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.75.

## APPLICANTS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- · Community Involvement within the past three years.
- · Academic Merit
  - Certified official transcript in sealed envelope required through the end of first semester or second trimester; First year college students are required to submit a high school transcript in addition to their college transcript; Graduate students are required to submit undergraduate transcript(s) in addition to graduate transcripts.
- Essay; 750- 1,000 words, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font.
   Essay Topic: "How has participating in Community Involvement transformed you and your academic journey?"
- Financial Need

The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision regarding a scholarship winner and payment. will be made directly to the college/university selected.

Applications must be received by Friday, March 15, 2024. Scholarship recipients will be notified in April 2023. Scholarships will be presented at an event in June. Send completed application to:

- A completed application form.
- A resume including any awards, certificates or honors received.
- An official or certified high school or college transcript; First year college applicants must submit their high school transcript along with their college transcript. Graduate students must submit undergraduate transcript as well as graduate transcript. Minimum GPA of 3.75 required.
- 750 1,000 word essay, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font on the topic:
   "How has participating in Community Involvement transformed you and your academic journey?"
