ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled, accepted, or awaiting acceptance to a college or university in an undergraduate or graduate program for the 2021 - 2022 academic year.
- Applicant, parent, or guardian **must be or become** a member of Naveo by submission deadline*.
- Deadline for submission is Friday, May 21, 2021.
- Only completed applications that follow essay guidelines will be considered. See reverse for application.
- Previous winners are not eligible to win consecutive years.

APPLICANTS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- Financial Need (may be verified)
- Academic Merit
 - **Certified official transcript in sealed envelope** required through the end of first semester or second trimester; First year college students are required to submit a high school transcript in addition to their college transcript; Graduate students are required to submit undergraduate transcript(s) in addition to graduate transcripts.
- School and Community Involvement in the past two years.
- Essay; 400- 500 words, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font.
Essay Topic: "Explain the importance of financial literacy and how it relates to you."

The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision regarding scholarship winners and payment will be made directly to the college/university selected.

Applications must be received by Friday, May 21, 2021. Scholarship recipients will be notified on or before Wednesday, June 9, 2021. Scholarships will be presented the week of June 14th.

- A completed application form.
- An **official or certified** high school or college transcript; First year college applicants must submit their high school transcript along with their college transcript. Graduate students must submit undergraduate transcript as well as graduate transcript.
- 400 - 500 word essay, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font on the topic: "Explain the importance of financial literacy and how it relates to you."

Failure to complete any portion of this application, follow essay guidelines or submit required documentation will result in disqualification. Verification of information may be requested.
