ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled, accepted, or awaiting acceptance to a college or university in an undergraduate or graduate program or full-time trade program for the 2026 - 2027 academic year.
- Applicant, parent, or guardian **must be or become** a member of Naveo by submission deadline*.
- Minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.75.

APPLICANTS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- Community Involvement within the past three years.
- Academic Merit
 - **Official transcript** is required through the end of the first semester or second trimester; First year college students are required to submit a high school transcript in addition to their college transcript; Graduate students are required to submit undergraduate transcript(s) in addition to graduate transcripts.
- Essay; 750- 1,000 words, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font.
Essay Topic: - "Discuss the importance of giving back to the community. How has your involvement in philanthropic activities enriched your life and the lives of others? Discuss your long-term goals for community service and philanthropy."
- Financial Need

The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision regarding a scholarship winner and payment.

Applications must be received by Friday, March 13, 2026. Scholarship recipients will be notified in May. Scholarships will be presented at an event in June.

- A resume including any awards, certificates or honors received.
- An **official** high school or college transcript; First year college applicants must submit their high school transcript along with their college transcript. Graduate students must submit undergraduate transcript as well as graduate transcript. **Minimum GPA of 3.75 required.**
- 750 - 1,000 word essay, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font on the topic: "Discuss the importance of giving back to the community. How has your involvement in philanthropic activities enriched your life and the lives of others? Discuss your long-term goals for community service and philanthropy."
